Overview

This act provides that a person convicted as an extended jurisdiction juvenile who violates the terms of a stayed sentence receives no credit for time spent in a juvenile facility prior to the revocation hearing.

- 1 **Execution of adult sentence.** Provides that a person convicted as an extended jurisdiction juvenile who violates the terms of a stayed sentence receives no credit for time spent in a juvenile facility prior to the summary hearing conducted to determine if the stayed sentence should be revoked and sentence executed.
