Overview

This act requires the commissioner of human services to study appropriate reimbursement for special transportation providers, and report to the legislature by September 15, 2000.

Study on reimbursement for special transportation providers. Requires the commissioner of human services, in consultation with special transportation providers, to study appropriate reimbursement for special transportation providers, and to present the study to the legislature by September 15, 2000. Requires the study to include an analysis of the cost characteristics of special transportation services, including the differences in costs for services provided to different classes individuals. Requires the commissioner to recommend reimbursement rates for services to these classes of individuals, based primarily on the analysis of service cost characteristics, capital cost characteristics, and industry growth cost characteristics.
