Current law requires charitable organizations to file annual reports with the state. Part of the current requirement is to file a copy of tax information submitted to the federal government.

This act provides that if a charitable organization has been granted a federal extension to file required federal information, the Attorney General may permit the charitable organization to file with its annual report a copy of the federal extension, and file its federal form with the state when it is required to be filed with the federal government. The act specifies conditions that must be met for this type of extension to be granted.
