Overview

This law clarifies provisions relating to limited licenses allowing manufactured home park owners to sell a small number of manufactured homes each year. Park owners may use these license, for instance, to sell abandoned manufactured homes left in their parks.

- 1 **Limited dealer's license.** Current law allows manufactured home park owners that allow the owner to obtain limited dealer's licenses authorizing them to sell up to five manufactured homes per year. This section clarifies requirements for the limited dealer's license application and the \$100 fee. The section also limits the information that can be required in order to renew an existing limited dealer's license.
- 2 **Effective date.** Provides that section 1 is effective the day following final enactment, and requires the commissioner to make application forms available and begin accepting applications within 60 days of that date.
