Provides that the state is not liable for damages arising from the use of a recreational vehicle on the right-of-way of a trunk highway, except when the state is guilty of conduct that would entitle a trespasser to damages against a private person.

"Recreational vehicle" for purposes of this act means a vehicle used for recreational purposes, including a snowmobile, trail bike, all-terrain vehicle, hovercraft, or licensed motor vehicle being used for off-road recreational purposes.
