Overview

Contains two provisions relating to memorials in the Capitol area.

- 1 **Firefighter memorial.** Requires the capitol area architectural and planning board to select an appropriate site in the capitol area for installation of the memorial to Minnesota firefighters that is now installed at the Minneapolis-St. Paul International Airport. Provides costs must be paid by nonstate sources.
- 2 **Combat wounded veterans.** Provides that a memorial plaque to honor combat wounded veterans may be placed in the court of honor on the capitol grounds. The plaque must be approved by the commissioner of veterans affairs and the capitol area architectural and planning board.
