Overview

This act modifies certain provisions of the expedited child support process.

- 1 **General.** Technical change.
- 2 **Contents of pleadings.** (a) Requires the initiating party, not necessarily the public authority, to include certain information in the pleadings in a child support action. Adds the following to the list of information required, if known:
 1. Dates of birth of the parties;
 2. Social security numbers of the parties' minor children (which is classified as private);
 3. The obligor's other support obligations; and
 4. Types and amounts of public assistance received by the parties.Deletes reference to providing information about each parties' number of household members and dependents.
(b) In addition to gathering certain income information, requires the public authority to gather information about:
 1. Total monthly child support and related support owed by the obligor in all IV-D cases;
 2. Public assistance received by the parties; and
 3. Other relevant information.
- 3 **Instruction to the revisor.** Instructs the revisor to change a headnote.
