Overview

This act phases out the use of MTBE and two other oxygenates in gasoline.

1 **Phase out of certain oxygenates.** Amends existing law relating to oxygenated gasoline to provide that after July 1, 2000, gasoline containing in excess of one-third of one percent of the following oxygenates may not be sold in the state:

methyl tertiary butyl ether (MTBE);

ethyl tertiary butyl ether (ETBE); and

tertiary amyl methyl ether (TAME).

After July 1, 2005, no gasoline containing any level of these oxygenates may be sold.
