Authorizes the town board of Hokah township in Houston county to adopt a resolution vacating a town road without authorization at the town meeting, where the vacation is made necessary because of road damage from a natural disaster. Makes the vacation subject to other provisions of town road vacation law.

Requires the town board to establish a cartway and to be responsible for the costs of constructing the cartway and paying damages to the owners of land on which the cartway lies, if a parcel of land would otherwise be left landlocked as a result of the emergency vacation.
