Exempts implements of husbandry from the requirement to have rear tail lamps if they are being towed by a motor vehicle at a speed of not more than 30 miles per hour, display a slow-moving vehicle emblem, and comply with the law requiring the last unit on a combination of implements of husbandry to show red reflectors to the rear.

This act is effective immediately.
