Redefines "residential roadway" by increasing the maximum length of a residential roadway from one-quarter mile to one-half mile.

Under other law designation of a local street or highway as a residential roadway allows the local road authority to reduce the speed limit on the roadway from the statutory 30 mph to 25 mph.
