Overview

Permits propane producers and propane retail marketers to form an education and research council supported by an assessment of up to one mill per gallon on propane producers and retail marketers.

Section

- 1 **Council.** Permits propane producers and propane retail marketers to form an education and research council.
- 2 **Organization.** States that organization and membership must comply with specified federal laws related to this issue. Provides that the council is established when the commissioner of public safety certifies it has been organized in compliance with federal law.
- 3 **Assessment.** Permits the council to assess propane producers and retail marketers an amount up to one mill per gallon of odorized propane, in a manner that complies with federal law.
- 4 **Annual report.** Requires the council to report annually to the commissioner of public safety, detailing collections and expenditures under this act.
- 5 **Contingent repealer.** The law is repealed August 1, 2004, if no council has been established by that date.
- 6 **Repealer.** The law is repealed August 1, 2009.
