Overview

Amends laws that authorize the commissioner of administration to enter into guaranteed energy savings contracts.

1 **Energy efficiency installments purchases.** Under current law, the commissioner of administration may contract to purchase by installment payments capital or other equipment or services intended to improve energy efficiency of a state building or facility. This section amends some of the conditions for these contracts.

provides the contracts may be used for purposes of reducing energy costs (in addition to the provision of current law stating that the contracts are to improve energy efficiency); extends the maximum term of the contracts from 10 to 15 years, and extends the maximum payback from 10 to 15 years, beginning at completion of the project;

provides that the savings used to determine cost of the contract includes measurable operating costs (as well as the savings in energy costs under current law);

Permits the state and the contract vendor to agree to a reasonable floor price for each type of energy used in the savings calculations at the time of contract execution.
