- 1. **Black police cars.** Allows vehicles of municipal police departments to be black. Under present law they may only be predominantly blue, brown, green, or white.
- 2-3 **Constables.** Deletes references to constables in the laws that specify who may make motor vehicle stops and operate an unmarked police vehicle.
- 4 **Security guard vehicles.** Allows a security guard to use a black vehicle in the course of employment if the vehicle was being used in this manner before August 1, 2002.
