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Definitions. Amends § 256B.69, subd. 2. States that a county board, or group of county boards operating under a joint powers agreement, is considered a prepaid medical assistance program (PMAP) or prepaid GAMC provider, if the county or group of county boards meet county-based purchasing requirements. Extends by two years, until July 1, 2004, the date through which Itasca county can continue to participate as a provider.
