- 1 **Trunk highway descriptions.** Changes the statutory description of legislative route no. 42 (T.H. 42) between Rochester and Kellogg by deleting reference to a segment between T. H. 14 and I-90.
- 2 **New route.** Designates a segment from T. H. 14 to I-90 as a new legislative route no. 338.
- 3 **Transfers.** Transfers legislative route no. 266 (T. H. 266) between Worthington and Wilmott to Nobles county, effective on signing of a turnback agreement between the county and MnDOT.

Transfers legislative route no. 273 (T. H. 273) between T. H. 67 and Belview to Redwood county, effective on signing of a turnback agreement between the county and MnDOT.

Vacates legislative route no. 302 (T. H. 302) between Sauk Center and the Minnesota Home for Girls.
