- **Definition of alkaline hydrolysis.** Defines "alkaline hydrolysis" as a means of reduction of a dead human body to essential elements and a form of final disposition.
- **Regulation of alkaline hydrolysis.** Provides that disposal of a dead human body by means of alkaline hydrolysis is subject to all requirements applicable to cremation.
