Provides that when railroad lands must be taken for a state trunk highway project and tracks must be relocated, the department of transportation may reimburse the railroad for the replacement land as an alternative to the department providing the replacement land itself. Provides that the choice between state reimbursement and state provision of the land will be made mutually by the department and the railroad.
