Repeals the requirement that requests from counties to designate natural preservation routes must be reviewed by an advisory committee consisting of a DNR representative, a county commissioner, a representative of an environmental organization, and three public members.

(Natural preservation routes are highways within the county state-aid highway system that by reason of being located in scenic or historically or environmentally sensitive areas may be built to different standards than other state-aid highways.)
