Provides that until July 1, 2005, seasonal weight limits (both statutory and posted) for trucks do not apply to garbage trucks that collect municipal mixed solid waste if they do not exceed 7 tons per axle. After that date these vehicles would go back to being subject to spring weight restrictions. Deletes the requirement that the garbage trucks must be two-axle in order to receive the limited exemption.

Amends the existing law that allows recycling vehicles engaged in locally-mandated curbside pickup to carry up to 10 tons per axle during spring weight restrictions, by reducing their maximum legal axle load to 7 tons until July 1, 2005. After that date the maximum legal axle load for these vehicles during spring weight restrictions would revert to 10 tons.

Provides that violations of spring weight restrictions by either recycling or garbage trucks are not subject to criminal penalties but only to civil fines for overweight.
