CHAPTER: 229 SESSION: 2004 Regular Session

TOPIC: Vehicles waiting at grade crossings

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Requires vehicles that are required to stop at a rail-highway grade crossing to remain stopped until the roadway beyond the grade crossing is sufficiently clear of traffic that the vehicle can proceed through the grade crossing without stopping until it is at least 10 feet beyond the farthest railroad track. This requirement applies to all vehicles where there is a train approaching, and to buses that are required to stop at all grade crossings.
