Overview

This act would exempt public pools with a zero-depth area, while accessible only by adults, from lifeguard requirements.

- Pools used for adult-only recreation.** Amends § 144.1222 by adding subd. 2c. Exempts a pool with a zero-depth area, when access is limited to individuals 18 years of age or older, from a requirement established in Minnesota Rules, part 4717.1850. (The rule requires that a lifeguard be present at all times the pool is in use.)

Effective date. States that this section is effective following final enactment.
