Expands the law that allows the Department of Public Safety to waive the behind-the-wheel driver's license exam for persons who have a valid license from another state that requires a comparable exam, by including licenses issued by a branch of the military that are valid or were valid at the time the licensee was discharged.

Allows the department to designate a period, up to a year, after discharge that the military license will be regarded as substituting for the behind-the-wheel exam.
