Overview

This act expands the membership of the Yellow Medicine County Hospital District board by allowing the elected members to appoint up to three additional members who are not members of the district.

1 Laws 1963, Chapter 276, Section 2, as amended by Laws 1992, Chapter 534, Sections 1 to 4. Adds subd. 2d. Allows the elected members of the Yellow Medicine County Hospital District board to appoint no more than three additional voting members who are not members of the district. Requires the terms of the appointed members to be designated at the time of the appointment and requires that the terms not exceed three years. Allows appointed members to: (1) be reappointed for successive terms; (2) have all the privileges of board membership; and (3) be removed from office for good cause by a two-thirds majority vote of the elected members.
