This act provides a total of \$10,379,000 in additional general fund appropriations and \$192,000 in state government special revenue fund appropriations for designated state agencies for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2007.

Procurements. Requires the Legislative Advisory Council to review proposed purchases by the Metropolitan Council when they exceed \$125 million.

Effective date. Provides an immediate effective date (May 3, 2007).
