Overview

Ratifies labor agreements, compensation plans, and salaries covering certain state employees that were approved by the Legislative Coordinating Commission Subcommittee on Employee Relations (SER). Under existing law, labor agreements and compensation plans are submitted to the SER. During legislative interims, agreements and plans are put into effect on an interim basis when approved by the SER. The agreements and plans are submitted to the entire legislature for ratification at the next legislative session.

Labor agreements and compensation plans.

Subd. 1. Minnesota Law Enforcement Association. Ratifies the labor agreement between the state and the Minnesota Law Enforcement Association.

Subd. 2. Minnesota Nurses Association. Ratifies the labor agreement between the state and the Minnesota Nurses Association.

Subd. 3. Office of Higher Education. Ratifies amendments to the compensation plan for unrepresented employees of the Office of Higher Education.

Subd. 4. Gambling Control Board director. Ratifies a salary increase for the director of the Gambling Control Board.

Subd. 5. PERA. Ratifies a salary increase for the director of the Public Employees

Subd. 6. MSRS. Ratifies a salary increase for the director of the Minnesota State Retirement System.

Subd. 7. TRA. Ratifies a salary increase for the director of the Teachers Retirement Association.
