Chapter 137 makes general fund appropriations to various state agencies for the settlement of claims. The appropriations include:

- \$49,954 to the Department of Corrections for payment of claims by persons incarcerated in state correctional facilities or performing correctional sentence-to-service or community service work for medical services or for permanent injuries suffered; and
- \$380 to the Department of Public Safety for reimbursement of unnecessarily large driver's license reinstatement fee caused by military service.

The Department of Revenue is also directed to pay \$830 as a property tax refund to replace a check that was delivered late by the post office.

This act is effective May 25, 2007.
