Overview

Chapter 210 makes three changes to procedures governing the disconnection of a building from heating, electricity, or water services because the landlord has failed to pay for them:

- makes posting notice of the impending disconnection mandatory by the utility, municipality, or company;
- allows the notice of disconnection to be placed on, as well as in, the building; and
- clarifies that a tenant or group of tenants may pay to have service reconnected.
