This law amends the definition of “fleet” in the section governing international registration plan (IRP) registration to include a single vehicle or two vehicles designated by the vehicle owner. Previously, this was allowable on a state-by-state basis. It goes into effect August 1, 2010.

IRP is a system that allows for registration of certain larger commercial motor vehicles in a home state and apportionment of registration taxes and fees proportionally across the states in which the vehicle travels.
