## Overview

This is the 2010 Omnibus Liquor Bill

## Section

- Sale of liquors. Allows the State Fair, rather than Ramsey County, to issue licenses for beer and Minnesota-produced wine. Defines Minnesota-produced wine to mean all farm winery wines.
- **Special provision; city of Minneapolis.** Allows an on-sale intoxicating liquor license to be issued to the Museum of Russian Art.
- **Wine licenses.** Allows state fair wine licenses for concessionaires.
- 4 Insurance required. Clarifies dram shop joint underwriting standards pursuant to a recent Supreme Court case -- Brua v. Minnesota Joint Underwriting Association. Incorporates the Supreme Court decision.
- 5 **Insurance not required.** Exempts wholesalers who donate wine to an organization for a wine tasting from the requirement that dram shop insurance is required.
- Tastings conducted by exclusive liquor store. Allows spirits or malt liquor tastings to be conducted; subjects malt liquor tastings to existing laws on wholesaler provision.
- **Authorization.** Allows the State Fair to license and regulate retail tobacco sales on the State Fairgrounds.
- 8 City of Minneapolis; liquor license. Technical fix from last year's revisor bill.
- 9 Minneapolis Campus of University of St. Thomas; on-sale license. Allows St. Thomas

- University to be issued a liquor license by Minneapolis.
- **Bemidji Regional Center; on-sale license.** Allows the Bemidji Regional Center to have an on-sale license.
- **Exemption; Bemidji State University.** Exempts Bemidji State University from a requirement that no more than one temporary license be give in a 30 day period.
