## Overview

Modifies elevator provisions.

Section

- **1 Elevator.** Strikes references to manlifts in grain elevators and feed mills, as well as, platform wheelchair lifts and elevators in churches from the definition of elevators.
- 2 **Operating permits, fees and inspections.** After issuance of an initial operating permit and payment of the fee, hand-powered manlifts and electric endless belt manlifts are not subject to subsequent operating permit fees and periodic inspections that are required for other types of elevators. Special purpose personnel elevators are subject to inspection not more than once every five years; elevators located in churches that do not have attached school facilities are subject to inspection not more than once every three years; all other elevators are subject to inspection not more than once each year.
