Overview

This act modifies issuance and securement of disability plates and certificates for motorcycles, and provides clarification on disability parking vehicle eligibility. The changes go into effect August 1, 2011.

Section

- **1 Disability plates; application.** Clarifies that (1) a single disability plate is to be issued for a motorcycle (as opposed to two plates for other motor vehicles), (2) the motorcycle disability plate must be the same size as a regular motorcycle plate, (3) various privileges and regulations governing disability plates apply only to those vehicles eligible to bear the plates. Makes technical changes.
- 2 Scope of privilege. Provides for proper display of a disability certificate on a motorcycle through securing it to the vehicle (instead of hanging it on a rearview mirror). Clarifies that the disability parking privileges provision applies only to eligible vehicles that bear disability plates or a certificate.
- **3 Identifying certificate.** Mandates issuance of a disability parking certificate that, when issued for a motorcycle, can be readily secured to the motorcycle. Clarifies that the certificate issuance provision applies only to eligible vehicles.
