Overview

Adds licensed ambulance service to the list of claimant agencies eligible to submit revenue recapture claims. Revenue recapture authorizes the Department of Revenue to intercept or offset part or all of a state tax refund or other payment to collect a debt that the taxpayer owes to a government agency or other authorized creditor.

Section

1 Revenue recapture; claimant agency. Adds licensed ambulance service to the list of claimant agencies eligible to submit revenue recapture claims. Strikes existing law that permits counties to submit revenue recapture claims on behalf of licensed ambulance services; under this bill the ambulance services would be authorized to submit claims directly.

Effective the day following final enactment.

2 Fee for administering claim. Strikes language allowing counties to charge ambulance services a fee to offset the cost of submitting claims on their behalf. Under section 1, counties would no longer be authorized to submit claims on behalf of ambulance services; making the fee obsolete.
