Overview

This bill lowers how much a lawful gambling organization in a bingo parlor must spend on charity to meet minimum requirements.

Section

Expenditure restrictions, requirements, and civil penalties. Changes the percentage that a lawful gambling organization doing business at a bingo parlor must spend on charitable contributions, from 30 percent minimum, to 20 percent minimum.
