This act expands the definition of qualified domestic violence-related offense (QDVRO) to include the crime of female genital mutilation. A previous QDVRO conviction or delinquency adjudication may be used to enhance penalties for the following crimes: violation of an order for protection, restraining order, or no contact order; stalking; domestic assault; and fifth-degree assault.
