TOPIC: Real estate closing agent licensure exemptions

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Overview

This act exempts various professional individuals and entities from the requirement to be licensed by the Department of Commerce as a real estate closing agent in order to handle real estate closings. The act is effective immediately.

- **License required.** References the closing agent licensing exemptions in section 2.
- **Exemption.** Exempt seven categories of professional individuals and entities from required licensure by the Department of Commerce in order to act as a real estate closing agent. The categories include licensed attorneys and their direct employees, licensed real estate brokers and salespersons and their direct employees, financial institutions, and title insurance companies.
