This act adds communication and documents made or used in a collaborative law process to the list of testimony that is excluded or privileged by Minnesota statute. It does not make previously discoverable information privileged by its use in the collaborative law process and it does not affect the privilege that is applicable to mediation and collaborative law projects in the common law. This also does not apply to the parties when there is an action to set aside a stipulated agreement resulting from a collaborative law process.
