

House Research Act Summary

CHAPTER: 109

SESSION: 2013 Regular Session

TOPIC: Juvenile delinquency; records/continuances

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This act prohibits direct public access to electronic juvenile delinquency records that are public under section 260B.163, subdivision 1, except in cases where: (1) the prosecutor has a filed a motion for adult certification, (2) the prosecutor designated or requested an EJJ proceeding, or (3) the juvenile has a prior adjudication for a non-drug related crime of violence. In these three instances, unless the juvenile or prosecutor agrees otherwise, the electronic record would remain available through direct public access.

Background: Under section 260B.163, subdivision 1, public juvenile record include those related to felony-level allegations where the child is 16 or 17 years old.
