Overview

This bill clarifies and amends duties and responsibilities of the secretary of state related to different administrative tasks, the classification of data, and notices.

Section

- **Email addresses.** Clarifies when an email address submitted to the secretary of state will be public.
- **Standard of conduct.** Provides standards of conduct for directors of cooperatives under chapter 308A.
- **Requirements.** Clarifies that the name of the registered agent in the articles of the cooperative only has to be listed if there is one registered agent.
- **Administrative dissolution.** Clarifies and changes when the secretary of state provides notice in an administrative dissolution.
- **Revocation of certificate of authority.** Clarifies and changes when the secretary of state must notify and issue a certificate of revocation to a foreign limited partnership.
- **Application to existing relationships.** Clarifies the application of the law to limited partnerships duration that were formed before January 1, 2005.
- **Statement of foreign qualification.** Changes the requirement for foreign partnerships having an alternative name, requiring the name to be listed on the statement of foreign

qualification.

Reinstatement. Adds assumed name certificates filed prior to September 5, 2011, to the certificates that can be reinstated.

- **Renewal notice.** Changes the requirements for the secretary of state on the renewal notice for a trademark or service mark.
- **Electronic access; liability; retention.** Removes the tax identification number, but not the Social Security number, from the data that is private or nonpublic in the electronic records of the secretary of state.
- **Restricted use of information.** Removes the tax identification number from the data that is considered private or nonpublic that is maintained by the secretary of state.
