TOPIC: Minnesota Historical Society

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Overview

Makes a number of changes in laws governing the Minnesota Historical Society.

Section

- 1** **Definitions; tort claims.** Includes the Minnesota Historical Society in the list of entities covered by the law governing tort claims against state agencies.
- 2** **Other eligible persons; insurance.** In the law governing eligibility for participation in the state employee group insurance program, refers to “an employee” of the Minnesota Historical Society, rather than referring to “a salaried employee”.
- 3** **Director’s responsibilities; historic preservation.** In the law governing the state historic preservation plan, updates references to federal laws.
- 4** **Historic Forestville.** In the law governing state historic sites, refers to “Historic Forestville”, rather than to “Meighen Store”.
- 5** **Sibley Historic Site.** Adds Sibley Historic Site in Dakota County to the statutory list of state historic sites.
- 6** **Washburn Crosby Complex (Mill City Museum).** Adds the Washburn Crosby Complex (Mill City Museum) in Hennepin County to the statutory list of state historic sites.
- 7** **Minnesota History Center.** Refers to the Minnesota History Center rather than to the State History Center.
- 8** **Repealer.** Removes Bourassa’s Fur Post in St. Louis County and William Le Duc House in Dakota County from the statutory list of state historic sites.
