Repeals Laws 1986, chapter 347, which authorized the city of Grand Rapids to create a Central School Commission. The commission was to be given “full operational responsibility for the Central School building, excluding the exterior grounds. The commission's objective in the management of Central School shall be to maximize the participation of community residents and visitors in the events and activities at the Central School, consistent with the historical heritage and cultural theme of the Central School.”

The Central School is a former school building that was renovated as a retail and community space.

Effective August 1, 2014.
