## Overview

This act expands special license plates offerings: one provision creates a new plate for retired firefighters and another creates a motorcycle plate for combat wounded veterans.

### Section

- 1 Firefighters; special plates, rules.** Clarifies that another special plate can be obtained following removal of special firefighter plates from a vehicle.
- 2 Retired firefighters; special plates.** Creates a new special plate for retired firefighters. Establishes plate eligibility, fees, allocation of funds, and exemptions from pre-requisites in establishing a new plate as well as from provisions on discontinuance of the plates.
- 3 General requirements; fees.** Establishes a special combat wounded veteran motorcycle plate. Previously, the special plate for combat wounded veterans had been limited to owners of passenger automobiles, one-ton pickup trucks used for noncommercial purposes, and recreational vehicles, who have received a Purple Heart medal.
