In 2014, the district was authorized to increase the maximum number of connections in the Cedar Lake Area Water and Sanitary Sewer District's comprehensive plan from 325 connections to 364 connections, subject to local approval. Ch. 308, art. 2, § 16, amending Laws 1999, ch. 243, art. 14, § 5, subd. 1, effective upon local approval. The connection increase is needed because Helena Township in Scott County wants to dissolve a subordinate service district (SSD) and use the surplus from the sale of property to pay to connect affected property owners to the Cedar Lake district. The district failed to complete local approval within the time allowed by statute. The 2015 law extends the time to file the certificate of local approval to June 30, 2015, and if it is filed by that date, the 2014 law is effective retroactively from May 21, 2014.
