Overview

This bill modifies the screening requirements for individuals who may have cooccurring mental health and chemical dependency disorders.

Section

Integrated co-occurring disorder treatment. Amends § 245.4863. Paragraph (a) makes a technical change to clarify that staff who perform chemical dependency assessments must screen clients for co-occurring mental health disorders, and that staff who perform mental health assessments must screen clients for co-occurring chemical substance use disorders. Adds that the screener must document the actions that will be taken if the clients screens positive for a co-occurring disorder.

Adds paragraph (b) which provides exceptions to the requirement for screening for cooccurring disorders.
