This bill authorizes counties who have participated in the Community Corrections Act (CCA) for five or more years to continue to participate in the CCA. Under current law, only counties that have a population of 30,000 or more may participate. This bill would create a CCA participation grandfather clause for smaller counties that have participated in the CCA – likely through a joint powers agreement with neighboring counties – for five or more years.

CCA counties provide all juvenile and adult probation services in their counties.
