## Overview

This act extends the sunset of an existing consumer-directed community supports budget methodology exception until a new exception is approved by the federal government.

## **Section**

1 Commissioner to seek amendment for exception to consumer-directed community supports budget methodology. Amends Laws 2012, ch. 247, art. 4, § 47, as amended by Laws 2014, ch. 312, art. 27, § 72. Extends the sunset of an existing exception to the consumer-directed community supports budget methodology. Removes an obsolete crossreference. Makes the amendments to this section effective June 1, 2016, and expire on the date a new consumer-directed community supports budget methodology exception becomes effective. Requires commissioner of human services to notify the revisor of statutes when the new exception becomes effective.
