Current law requires that at least one member of a local board of appeal and equalization who has attended an appeals and equalization course in the last four years must be present at each board meeting. This act provides a waiver under this requirement for a city or town that certified it was in compliance with current law by February 1, 2016, but who did not have a board member present at a meeting in 2016, and reinstates the powers of the local board, subject to a local resolution and certification that it is now in compliance with current law.
