This act broadens the “move over law,” which directs motorists to change lanes away from emergency vehicles and other vehicles (including tow trucks, road maintenance, utility, and road construction vehicles) that are stopped on or at the side of the road with lights activated.

It requires a driver to slow down when passing the stopped vehicle (1) on a road that only has one lane in the motorist’s direction of travel, or (2) if the driver cannot move to another lane on a multilane road.
