This act prohibits a person from entering or attempting to enter into an agreement with a military beneficiary that assigns the beneficiary's pay or benefits to another party in a manner that violates federal law. A person who violates this provision is subject to a cause of action for damages and payment of reasonable attorney's fees and costs to the individuals harmed. The law also grants the Attorney General enforcement power.
