### Overview

This act modifies civil commitment discharge provisions for persons committed as mentally ill and dangerous, sexually dangerous, or persons with a sexual psychopathic personality, clarifying that a person may not be discharged if the person is in need of treatment and supervision, whether inpatient or other form treatment. The act makes the change effective for any person currently civilly committed, and any civil commitment discharge or reduction in custody petition that is pending and has not received a final order of discharge.
